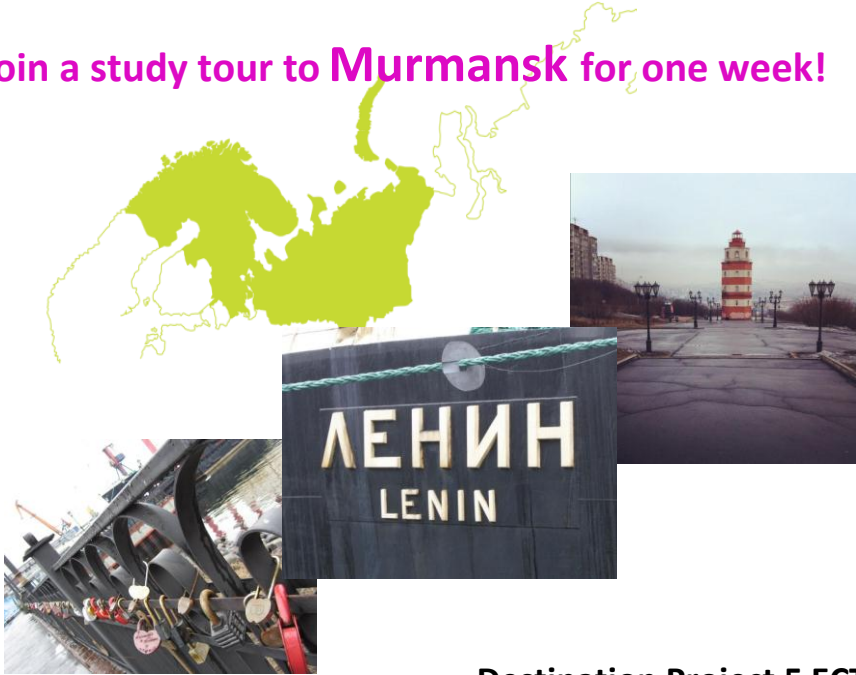

**Requirements?**

- ✓ Have to be enrolled in one of the educational institutions (RAMK, TOKEM, University of Lapland) of the Lapland University Consortium
- ✓ Should be interested in new cultures, traveling and the Barents Region in particular
- ✓ Should have at least 100 ECTS in previous studies
- ✓ Should have successfully completed (or being currently enrolled in) the study unit Destination Management (or 5 ECTS in equivalent studies)
- ✓ Must have a valid passport (for visa)
